What are Fresh Bucks?



Fresh Bucks supports the health and well-being of our community by helping participants afford more locally grown foods including fruits, vegetables, meat, poultry, seafood, dairy, eggs, bread and seeds and plants which produce food. Participants will receive \$40 in Fresh Bucks per Market Day to be used at the SJI Farmers Market.

How do I qualify for Fresh Bucks?

If you are on SNAP, WIC, or your income is at/below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, you qualify for Fresh Bucks! Enroll with the QR code or find the enrollment form on www.sanjuancountywa.gov.

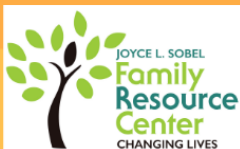
