What are Fresh Bucks?



Fresh Bucks is a locally funded program that supports the health and well-being of our community by helping participants afford more locally grown foods including fruits, vegetables, meat, poultry, seafood, dairy, eggs, bread and seeds and plants which produce food. Participants will receive \$20 per individual or up to \$40 per household in Fresh Bucks on Saturdays to be used at the SJI Farmers Market.

How do I qualify for Fresh Bucks?

If you are on SNAP, WIC, or your income is at/below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, you qualify for Fresh Bucks! Enroll with the QR code, go online at jlsfrc.org/fresh-bucks, or visit the Joyce L Sobel Family Resource Center in person.

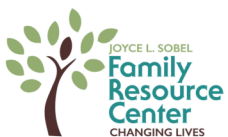
